

History and Location

The newly inaugurated Teatro della Signoria was originally built in the 18th century and still possesses its original stunning wood structure. Located on the corner of via dei Cimatori and via Dei Cerchi adjacent to Florence's world renowned Piazza Della Signoria, the Teatro della Signoria will once again have a beating heart in the centre of Florence. Originally built in the typical Italian style with its asymmetrical horseshoe floorpan, the theatre features several tiers of boxes and a seating capacity of 300 allowing for both grand and intimate experiences.

From the 18th century through the most recent decades, the theatre underwent numerous changes in both name and function. The space began life as a pilgrim hostel which was later converted into a hospital known as Vecchia Quarconia. When the location was transformed into a theatre it became known as Teatro della Quarconia, then Teatro del Giglio, regional Teatro Leopoldo II, Teatro Nazionale, Olimpia Varieta, and in the 1930's, a movie theatre called "Cinema-teator Nazionale," one of the most popular in Florence, however it fell into disrepair and has been closed for the past 40 years.

With thanks to Archea Associati and Marco Casamonti, the remarkable theatre that has been on this location for 300 years will be restored and come back to life as a cultural heartbeat in the centre of one of the world's most glorious cities, Florence.

The fortuitous encounter with a complete artist like Hershey Felder, a recently established resident of Florence, was an immediate meeting of the minds and artistic sensibilities. He too represents an eclectic company: after 28 years of theatrical productions and over 6,000 live performances, Hershey Felder created "Live from Florence, An Arts Broadcasting Company", which has produced more than eighteen movies so far (just to mention a few: "Chopin and Liszt in Paris"; "Violetta, the story of Verdi's Traviata"; "Dante and Beatrice in Florence"; "Mozart and Figaro in Vienna"; the story of Sergei Rachmaninov; the story of the famous opera composer Giacomo Puccini). World renowned productions include: "George Gershwin Alone", "Monsieur Chopin"; "Beethoven"; "Maestro" (Leonard Bernstein); "Franz Liszt in Musik, Lincoln: An American Story", "Hershey Felder as Irving Berlin", "Our Great Tchaikovsky", "A Paris Love Story" (Debussy) and "Chopin in Paris". Since its inception in 2001, Hershey has been the president of "Hershey Felder Presents" managed a theatrical and cinema production company. a production company. Currently, Hershey resides in Florence, where he also has his film studio in nearby Bagno a Ripoli.
